Colour: Saturated deep magenta red.

Bouquet: Crisp, clean raspberry fruits with black, blue and purple current preserve, with dark strawberry jam and blackberry; surrounded by underlying hints of butterscotch, menthol and spice.

Palate: A lively refreshing and medium bodied palate. Comprising sweet berry fruits, ripest plums and cassis, with hints of chocolate molasses, caraway seed and fennel.

Analytical Data: Alcohol 13.5%, Total acidity: 6.9 g/l, Residual sugar: 42.7 g/l, pH: 3.44

Vintage Comments:

Yield: 5-6 tonnes per acre

Harvest: A typically hot and dry growing season was preceded by a warm dormant period, with little winter rainfall. This resulted in reduced yields across the vineyard, although limited rain ensured the production of intensely rich and concentrated aroma, along with flavour development.
