The 2012 vintage was an outstanding year. Very good subsoil moisture which was carried over from 2011, alongside a reasonable and consistent average summer rainfall, with moderate to below average daily temperatures complemented and assisted with very good canopy health throughout the course of the 2012

season.

Overall the red varieties are every bit as good as the best years over the past two decades. The 2012 vintage truly was one of the great years reflected by the outstanding flavour and natural acidity.
